Abstract: *The same line – summary of the text – 11 pt. Times New Roman, Italic, Justified, summarizing the material in the respective context. The length of the abstract should be maximum 3 – 4 lines.*

Key words: *5 to 8 key words, separated by comma – 11 pt. Times New Roman, Italic, Justified.*

INTRODUCTION

Please, paste here and the requirements will be met. It is easy! The paper should contain the compulsory elements. After the title, the author's names (without academic titles and degrees), the institution, the paper should begin with an introduction, which presents preliminary information on the topic and orients the reader to the content. The introduction contains information on the current state of the problem researched in the paper. It is necessary to make a theoretical overview of the problem presented in the paper. The research methodology can then be presented followed by results and/or discussion. It ends with a conclusion.

Pages should NOT be numbered!

The text of the paper should be in camera-ready form in one column, justified, Times New Roman, font size=11pt., single line spacing.

Total paper size – 5 - 6 pages in word format (a longer article will cost more to be published).

The first line of all paragraphs (together with the titles of the sections and subsections) must be 0.75 cm tab (first line=0.75 cm). Paragraphs should be justified, line spacing – single.

Avoid footnotes!

For citations in the text, the number of the source must be indicated in square brackets. [1] For more detailed information, see the **Citation and References** section.

The tables and figures in the text should have clear symbols and be of good quality, and high-resolution photos. When sending the article, attach the figures in separate files in jpg or pdf format, numbering them in the same order as in the text.




Fig. 1 Figure name – 11 pt., (TNR, centered), Italic, one blank line below figure [1]

It is recommended that figures are named “Fig.” (Font 11 pt. TNR, Italic), number, space and name of figure. All figures should be quoted in the text (see Fig. 1). The source of the figure should be mentioned and/or put as a reference in brackets.

Tables should be 11 pt., one blank line above and below table. Table caption should be as follows: Table, space, number, full stop/period, space, name of table – 11 pt., TNR, bold, centered.

The conclusion summarizes the information of the paper, the basic conclusions and author’s contributions, gives perspective on future work on the issue.

REFERENCES

References contain quoted sources in the order they are mentioned in the text (not in an alphabetical order). In the text the quoted article/book should be put in square brackets [1] with the same number as in the references section. The reference should include the following: author's name, title, publisher, year of publication, and pages. See the example below. Immediately after the Reference section comes the information about the author/s. The authors are to be numbered in Arabic numerals.

The information about the author (see above) must be maximum 2 - 3 lines of text.

The pages are not numbered!!! It is not recommended to automatically place notes after the text!

The figures are saved as separate files as well in jpg or pdf format and are sent together with the paper, correctly marked with the names of the figures or their sequence in the text.
